At 11:00 a.m. we will enter The Music Room to enjoy a Wednesday Morning Concert Recital "Autumn Leaves." This room with its sense of intimacy and perfect acoustics is perhaps the finest chamber music venue in the New York area.



At 12:00 our tour of the Rosen House will include twenty magnificent rooms with vast collections of Eastern, Medieval and Renaissance art and antiques - and entire rooms from European palaces and country homes. This extraordinary collection was assembled by Caramoor's founders Walter T. Rosen and Lucie Bigelow Dodge Rosen.
